Scenario

- It is the year 2030 and a new unknown virus is spreading rapidly across the global. Having learned some lessons from COVID-19 in 2019-2021 governments are responding quickly to the threat this new virus poses.
- You, a group of 4-5 experts, have been contacted by the local government to begin putting in place a response for victims of gender-based violence in your town.

What you have been asked to do (45 minutes)

- Prepare a brief explanation (report) of the response you propose. What kind of response do you propose (is it specific to an issue or a more wholistic response)?

- Who (what kind of people) will you need to work on this with you?
- What kind of resources will you need?
- What is the goal of the response?
